Mr. Faessler, embarked on his banking career in 1968 at Bank Leu in Zurich. Over the years, he gained experience through postings in London, Nassau, and Luxembourg. In 1981, Mr. Faessler relocated to the TCI, where he later became a naturalized British Citizen and obtained TCI Citizenship status. During his career, Mr. Faessler established the Turks and Caicos Banking Company (TCBC) and served as its President until his retirement in August 2016. His contributions extend beyond banking; he held prominent roles such as Chairman of the Invest TCI Agency and was instrumental in founding the TCI Bankers Association, where he served as President for seven years.

Additionally, he has been actively involved in the local community, serving as President of the Chamber of Commerce, a Member of the Investment Committee of the National Insurance Board (NIB), and a Board member of the Financial Services Commission (FSC).

Currently, Mr. Faessler continues to contribute his expertise as a non-executive Director of Caribbean Management Services. He holds the Chairmanship of the FIA and has been appointed as Chairman of the National Wealth Fund.
