

## **Hon. Attorney General Rhondalee Braithwaite Knowles, OBE, KC, Board Member, Ex- officio**

Honourable Attorney General



Rhondalee Braithwaite Knowles, OBE, K.C., a native of Grand Turk, has an

illustrious career in law and public service. After completing her high school education at Turks and Caicos High School, she earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Government and History with honours from Liberty University, USA, followed by a Bachelor of Laws degree with honours from the University of the West Indies, Cave Hill, Barbados. She also received a Certificate of Legal Education from the Eugene Dupuch Law School in the Bahamas, graduating second in her class.

Her legal career began in the Attorney General's Chambers, where she ascended from Crown Counsel

designate to Principal Crown Counsel, leading the Commercial/Civil division. She made history as the first Turks and Caicos Islander appointed Deputy Attorney General on April 1, 2008, and was awarded an OBE in 2013. In February 2014, she became the first Turks and Caicos Islander, the youngest person, and the first woman to be appointed Attorney General of the TCI. Further, she was the first female attorney admitted to the inner bar of the TCI as King's Counsel on March 15, 2019. She chaired the 2019 Constitution Review Committee, demonstrating her dedication to legal excellence and constitutional reform. Her roles as Chair of the Anti-Money Laundering Committee (AMLC) and ex officio Board Member of the Financial Intelligence Agency (FIA) highlight her commitment to upholding legal standards and enhancing public sector integrity.
